HUNTING AREA:

The hunting area of Schönfeld Hunting Safaris covers over 200,000 hectares of the best hunting territories of Namibia. Hunting is done in various parts of the country, depending on the trophy animals required by the clients. The area is covered partly by bushy savannah, camel thorn savannah, and partly by open flat areas with lime pans. The Kalahari-area consists of red flat sand dunes with wide open grass plains. During the rainy season from December till April it rains approx. 350 mm (14") p.a. In the other months we normally have dry, sunny and cloudless weather. The most agreeable temperatures are from March until October. From May to August it may be quite chilly in the early morning, with temperatures below freezing point possible before sunrise or after sunset. The hunting season is closed during December and January.

ACCOMMODATION:

The Schönfeld Farm with the Seydlitz Castle offers accommodation for high demands. The rooms are tastefully furnished and each has an en-suite bathroom. Hair dryer and an input for shavers are available. Let yourself be pampered and enjoy good meals in a familiar atmosphere. Swimming pool, TV room, an extensive library, game drives, photo-hides at the waterhole, camera stalking for many bird and game species and porcupine feeding will ensure that you have an unforgettable African holiday. Accommodation in the concession areas may differ. Please inform us in reasonable time about any dietary requirements (diabetes, vegetarian, etc.).

We are also happy to arrange all other activities upon request. For example horseback riding on our farm horses, nature walks, climbing the Okongue Mountain, rifle target shooting, quad bike rides, trips to nearby attractions and much more.

REQUIRED FOR HUNTING:

Check visa requirements for your country. Field grade shotgun, bow and / or rifle. Cal. .375, .300, .30 06 with .270 as minimum, plus 60 rounds ammunition. Each client has to declare his hunting weapons/ ammunition at the airport where he will obtain, without difficulty, a temporary rifle import permit valid for the duration of his safari. No handguns allowed in Namibia. Binoculars, camera, film, rifle ownership permit of your country. Light hunting clothes (green or khaki) not too much, as laundry is done daily. Warm windbreaker (parka and sweater), light hunting boots, broad brimmed hat, sunglasses, suntan and lip protection. Malaria + Hepatitis: check with your doctor.

BOOKING INFORMATION:

A Visa is required to enter the country. Please provide us accordingly with your full name and address, exact dates and times of arrival and departure in Namibia as well as your flight number and airline. Please confirm your arrival by email or phone at least 3 days prior to arrival.

BOOKING:

Booking Forms will be sent on request.

A deposit of Euro 1000.00 per hunter and Euro 500.00 per accompanying person/on-hunter is required on confirmation of booking. 2nd payment, which covers the rest of the booked safari, is due 30 days before arrival. All Trophy fees and other expenses are fully due at the end of the hunt. Scenic safaris: 100% payment with confirmation of quote and instructions to book the safari.

Conversion from Euro to Namibia Dollar at published daily rate with payments inside Namibia. Payments in Namibia can only be made to our Namibian Account (Bank Windhoek - Omaruru). 1,5% surcharge will be added on card payments

LIABILITY:

Any safari is potentially hazardous and it is essential that lawful directions and advice of the safari operator be followed.

We request our clients to arrange for their own insurance as we do not accept responsibility for loss, illness, accidents or delays, nor any expenses arising thereof. We undertake to exercise the utmost care and precaution to ensure our client's safety. Namibian laws apply.

CANCELLATION:

Deposit will be refunded only if client cancels the safari within 30 (thirty) days after date of confirmation of booking, subject to a 15 % administration fee and provided cancellation is done at least 90 (ninety) days prior to the date of commencement of safari.

FLIGHTS:

Nonstop flights from Frankfurt or Munich to Windhoek are operated by Lufthansa/Discover or Ethiopian Airlines with a layover in Addis Ababa.
